

Biography Korneel Evers

Korneel Evers is a Dutch actor and comedian. Together with Arjan Smit and Chris King Perryman he forms the multiple awarded cabaret trio *Brokstukken*. He plays one of the lead roles in the telefilm *Rabarber* (2014) and the film *The Heineken Kidnapping* (2011) a true story about the largest and most famous kidnapping case in The Netherlands.

Korneel is born in Almelo where he lives until he's 8 years old. After that he moves to Wierden where he finishes high school. During his high school period Korneel gets his first taste in acting when he becomes part of the school's theatergroup *Titsing*. When he's 15 Korneel starts playing in various rock bands such as *Fairfight* (guitarist) and *The Guides* (singer/guitarist).

After going to college, first to become a social worker and later on to be a teacher, which he both studied for only one year, Korneel decides to start working to find out what he really wants in life. He takes on a job as a garbage man. During this period Korneel auditions for the School Of Arts in Utrecht. He gets accepted and in 2004 he graduates in Acting at the Arts and Theater Faculty. During and after completing his studies Korneel plays with several theatre groups.

In 2005 Korneel reaches the finale of the prestigious Dutch *Leids Cabaret Festival* with the trio *Brokstukken*. Since then the trio has been touring theaters throughout the country, as well as playing many festivals. Currently they are touring the country with the show *Heavy Balls*.

Korneel can be seen in various films and television series. He was a member of the cabaret improvisational TV show *Pool Guests* and played in several Dutch TV series, such as *Penoza*, *Freshmen* (season 2), *Danni Lowinsky*, and in *Merry Christmas!*. In 2015 he can be seen in the new drama series *Black Tulip*.

In 2016 he is back on stage with *FC De Rebellen* a performance about soccer.
