

Biography Susan Radder

Susan Radder (1999) is one of the most promising young acting talents of her generation. She played lead roles in films like HORIZON (2016), PAINKILLERS (2014) and JACKDAW BOY (2012). At the Netherlands Film Festival 2016 she was nominated for Best Actress for her role in HORIZON, the jury describes Susan as a 'young miracle'.

Susan Radder was born in Amsterdam on March 20, 1999. She first came to the scene at the age of 6, when she made her acting debut in SACRIFIED (2005). Susan was discovered by director Dana Nechushtan by coincidence when she joined her mother for a day to her work as a children casting coach involved in this project. Shortly after, the young actress could be seen in an episode of TV series SHOUF SHOUF! (2006) directed by Tim Oliehoek.

Her first leading role on the big screen came in 2012 in the feature JACKDAW BOY directed by Boudewijn Koole. This youth film received 13 awards, among which Best Youth Film at the Berlin International Film Festival 2012, and the Young Audience Award at the European Film Award 2012.

In that same year Susan played another role on the big screen opposite Barry Atsma and Pierre Bokma, in Dick Maas his movie QUIZ (2012), and in TV series HIDDEN STORIES, where true stories of children are re-enacted by actors. In 2014 Susan played her second lead role in the movie PAINKILLERS (2014), based on a Carry Slee novel, and she could be seen on the small screen in the short film FOR EMILA (2014) directed by Maria Smits.

A year later Susan could be seen in family film JACK'S BIRTHDAY WISH (2015) directed by Anne de Clerq, short film RAAF (2015), and tv series TESSA (2015).

In 2016 she is playing the feisty teenager Lieke in the One Night Stand film HORIZON (2016), for this role she receives a Golden Calf nomination for best actress and an award for best actress at the TV Beelden. According to the rapport of the judges of the Netherlands Film Festival Susan showed some strong acting skills while playing the young Lieke. The jury was most impressed by the self-confidence Susan showed in close-ups and she was a true revelation to all judges.

In this same year she could also be seen in successful tv series such as A'DAM EN E.V.A., FIGHTERS HEART and MURDER WOMAN.

Up next are the feature film GEK VAN ORANJE and the lead in a short TV movie.

Susan just finished high school and is currently orientating on different drama academies.
