

BIOGRAPHY GEORGINA VERBAAN

Georgina Verbaan (1979) is much appreciated for the diversity of her talent. She is an actress, singer and published her first book 'Loze Ruimte' in 2016. She is known for various television and film productions. Her talent is awarded with two Golden Calves, including the award for Best Actress for her role in THE SURPRISE (2015).

In 2007 Georgina receives the Sound and Vision Award for Best Actress for her performance in 'T SCHAEP (2006 - 2015). She is widely praised for her impersonation of Tilly in GODFORSAKEN! (2011), for which she also received the same Sound and Vision Award for Best Actress. The episode she is in also receives a Golden Calf nomination in 2012.

She could be seen in films such as THE MARATHON (2012), MEN IN THE CITY (2013), HEART STREET (2014), THE SURPRISE (2015) and JACK'S WISH (2015). For THE MARATHON, directed by Diederick Koopal, she received a Golden Calf for Best Supporting Actress in 2013 and for her role in THE SURPRISE, directed by Mike van Diem, the Golden Calf for Best Actress at the Netherlands Film Festival 2015.

Early 2016 she could be seen in the film BRASSERIE VALENTINE (2016) in which she plays the title role. Later that year in the family film MEESTER KIKKER (2016) and the romantic comedy HEART FIGHT (2016) directed by Janice Pierre.

On stage she could be seen in the play VENUS (2016) opposite Jeroen Spitzenberger directed by Johan Doesburg.

Her recent television credits include REMI, NOBODY'S BOY (2016) and LA FAMIGLIA (2016). In 2017 she stars next to Barry Atsma and Jacob Derwig in the successful series KLEM (2017). She is set to play Kitty in the second season of KLEM, for which she recently received the 'Golden Notekraker' for Best Television Actor.
