YOOTHA WONG-LOI-SING - BIOGRAPHY

Yootha Wong-Loi-Sing (1987) is a Dutch actress and singer. She first came to the scene in the Dutch feature film THE PRICE OF SUGAR, the opening film of the Netherlands Film Festival 2013. At the same festival, Yootha was nominated the Golden Calf for Best Actress, for her portrayal of the free minded slave Mini-Mini in 18th century colonial Surinam.

THE PRICE OF SUGAR has been adapted for television as a 4 part miniseries, reaching about 1 million people per episode, which is considered a huge success in the Netherlands.

In 2015 Yootha stars in THE PARADISE SUITE by acclaimed Dutch director Joost van Ginkel, starring Isaka Sawadogo in the lead role. The film won Best Film at the Netherlands Film Festival 2016 and was that year's Dutch submission for the Academy Awards.

She went on to play lead roles on the big screen in the Dutch horror thriller SNEEKWEEK (2016) and the friendship comedy ALLES VOOR ELKAAR (2017). Also, she stars in Dutch TV series such as PROJECT ORPHEUS and SUSPECTS and the TV movies CAS (2017) and GET LOST (2018). She can be seen in the Nickelodeon series DE LUWDIGS and its US remake HUNTER STREET, which have both been picked up for a second season, scheduled to air in 2018.
