

VINCENT VAN DER VALK – BIOGRAPHY

After graduating high school actor en screenwriter Vincent van der Valk (1985) decides to broaden his horizon and leaves The Netherlands to study in China. After two years he moves to New York to study at The Circle In The Square Theatre School in New York. In 2006 Vincent returns to the Netherlands where he's accepted to the renowned Maastricht Theatre Academy from which he graduates in 2010.

In the following years Vincent receives several awards and nominations for his (leading) roles in film and on stage including a Golden Calf nomination for Best Actor (GLUCKAUF, 2014), the Golden Poison Cup Award (CALIGULA, 2014) and the prestigious theatre 'Arlecchino' award for Best Supporting Actor (ANGELS OF AMERICA, 2015).

Not committing himself to just one, Vincent joins several renowned theatre companies in Germany, Belgium and the Netherlands. Most recently he could be seen playing the lead role in PLATONOV (2018) and will return in 2019 in the reprise of the succesful CALIGULA. Meanwhile he combines his theatre work with roles in succesful TV productions (KLEM, GODFORSAKEN, CRUIJF, RAMSES and SUSPECTS) and film (NOCTURNE).

Besides being a versatile actor Vincent is also a screenwriter for television and Dutch and German theatre, as well as a coach for students at the Amsterdam School of Art.
