

BRAM SUIJKER – BIOGRAPHY

Bram Suijker (1989) is an award winning Dutch actor, who graduated from the renowned Maastricht Theatre Academy in The Netherlands.

While still in drama school, he landed roles in several critically acclaimed Dutch TV shows and films, such as GODFORSAKEN (2012), ACCORDING TO ROBERT (2013) and SKY HIGH (2012), the latter by award winning director Shady El-Hamus.

In 2013, Bram took an internship at the Dutch National Theatre and played in MIGHTY SOCIETY. Shortly after graduating, Bram joined the prestigious ensemble, where he could be seen in leading roles in ORESTEIA, SHAKESPEARE'S COMPLETE WORK IN SHORT, AMADEUS, LORD OF THE FLIES and the latest WE ARE HERE FOR ROBBIE. Meanwhile he continued his TV work by playing roles in well-received series such as ACCORDING TO JACQUELINE (2016) and ICARUS (2016) and the upcoming teen series KITTENS.

Bram received the Best Actor award at Shortcutz Festival for his leading role in the short film BALLS (2013) and Best Actor for GIRAFFE (2016) at the 48 Hour Project. His theatre work gets recognized too, and he picked up the Piket Art Award 2017, a prestigious Dutch theatre award for upcoming artists under 30, for which he had already been nominated the year before as well.

Bram combines his theatre work with roles in film and television. Recent credits include ZUIDAS (2018), a Dutch legal drama television series, and the television film LOST & FOUND (2018).
